<u>Approval of Board Meeting Minutes</u>: Lee Means moved to accept the minutes, as presented, of the March 20, 2023, Board meeting. Raymond Byrne, Jr. seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: A motion to file the treasurer's report for the month of March, subject to audit, was made by Raymond Byrne, Jr. Lee Means seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Chief's Report: Chief Bucich's written report was included in the Board packet. Also discussed:

Water Tank: Chief Bucich reported that the tank has been installed. A final inspection will be required. Once the inspection is complete there will be minimal sitework to clean up and finish the area around the tank.

Staff Vehicles: The new staff vehicle for Chief Bucich was put into service last week. His previous truck will be available for use by the Duty Officers. Chief Bucich recommends selling Deputy Chief Thompson's vehicle (1694) once his new staff vehicle is put into service.

<u>Lee Means made a motion to surplus the 2008 Ford F250 4x4 for. Raymond Byrne, Jr. seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.</u>

New Engine: The new engine remains at Hughes Fire while they complete the list of repair items. It has been noted that many of the repair items were identified while the engine was still in Florida and not repaired prior to shipping it to Oregon. Chief Bucich will provide updates as they become available.
